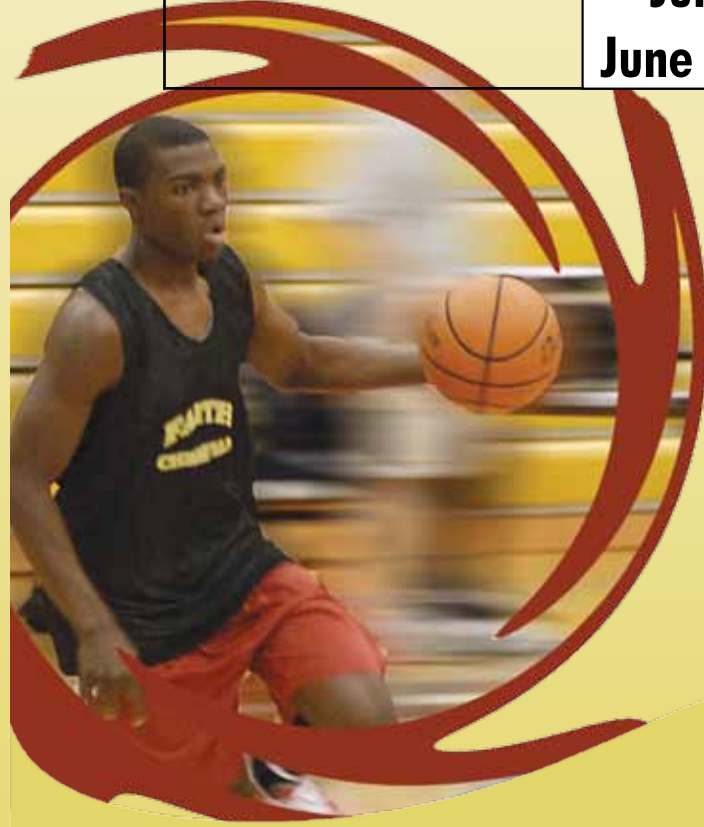

## Our Mission

## Meet the Staff

**Kevin Templeton** is one of the most respected Christian coaches in the Southeast. With 33 years of coaching experience, he has demonstrated his ability to build a program from the ground up. He has 25 years of high school coaching experience and 8 years of college coaching experience. During his coaching tenure at Tennessee Temple University, the 2002–2003 TTU squad went 30-4 and won Temple's seventh NCCAA title. Coach T has a reason for coaching above and beyond winning games, which is to influence kids to live for Christ.

**Tommy Brown** is the head men's basketball coach at Lee University. In his very first season at Lee, Brown directed the Flames to the Southern States Athletic Conference regular season and tournament championships and was named the SSAC Coach of the Year. Since being at Lee, he's taken six straight teams to the NAIA National Tournament and claimed several regular season and conference tournament titles.

**Marty Rowe** is the head women's coach at Lee University. He has led the Lady Flames to seven 20-plus win seasons and seven consecutive appearances in the NAIA National Tournament. In 2006 he was awarded NAIA National Coach of the Year. In 2008, his Lady Flames were ranked up to number 2 in NAIA I. In 2010, the Lady Flames finished in the semifinals of the NAIA National Tournament.

**Josh Templeton** returns as a headliner. A two-time NCCAA All-American, his point guard clinic is a highlight for all. He connects with young people and can teach the game in a way that helps each camper improve. He is an assistant coach for Coach Brown and the Lee University Flames. His specialties are player development and helping to develop the offense.
